The meeting commenced with the warm welcome of all the members of the Governing Body by Hon'ble Principal Dr. N. P. Tendolkar. Hon. Sadanadaji Bhagwat, Chairperson, D.S.P.M., chaired the meeting as per the request by Dr Tendolkar.In the preface, Hon. Chairman said he is extremely happy about the New Education Policy (NEP-2020) that calls for building the National Mission on Foundational Literacy and Numeracy, brilliant academic reforms etc. He said, from the last year itself, the college has been working very proactively towards implementation of NEP. Autonomy has given us the privilege to implement NEP very effectively. Mr Bhagwat observed that, after autonomy, the college has started three vocational programs (B.Voc) in Banking, Agriculture and Geo-informatics. From this year, the college has decided to offer skill courses to each and every student and shortlisted 33 courses to begin with. For this, the management is constructing new educational facilities

with a Vocational Education Centre having a worth of Rs. 3 Cr. Hon. Chairman thanked all the members and continued the formal part of the meeting.

Item No. 3 Initiation of New Program/s of Study w.e.f. 2023-24

Hon. President Mr.Sadanandji Bhagwat observed that Hon Prin. Dr. Tendolkar informed and requested the management to initiate the master program in the Commerce, particularly in Banking and Finance, as he has been receiving inquiries from students and parents. He said, about 80 students every year from this college and almost equal in number from the colleges around successfully complete their graduation in commerce. Our B.Voc Banking and Finance students would also get an opportunity to continue their post-graduation. Furtheron, Mr Bhagwat said, to make B.Com program four years integrated, as per the NEP, initiation of M.Com degree ought to be on priority list. Post-graduation programs in Arts and Science are, already, in place. Hon Chairman appealed to all the members to resolve unanimously for initiating M.Com.program in Banking and Finance w.e.f 2023-24. Principal Dr. Tendolkar said that the syllabus of the University of Mumbai will be followed for M.Com. Program for the time being and, then, it could be placed before the various authorities of the college for the review if required.

Item No. 4 Implementation of NEP 2020 w.e.f. 2023-24

Hon. Prin. Dr. N. P. Tendolkar briefed Dr. R.D. Kulkarni committee report that was accepted by Govt of Maharashtra for the implementation of National Education Policy. As per the report, departments having established P.G and research centers can only have the privilege to start a four years degree program. In regard to this, the college is planning to commence four-year degree programs in Physics, Chemistry and Geography; from the year 2023-24.

Item No. 5 To Take Decision on Recruitment of Teachers for the Year 2023-24

Hon. Prin. Dr. Tendolar put forth requirements of teachers for the year 2023-24 as per workload. He briefed about the 07 vacant positions of assistant professors in the various departments. As per the present government policy, the college has initiated the recruitment process for the appointment of assistant professors on purely Clock Hour Basics (CHB). Hon.

Prin. Tendolkar appealed to the members to approve the appointment process of the assistant professors on the CHB s. Mr.Krushnakumar Bhosale said that as per prevailing rules, teachers be recruited.

It was unanimously resolved that the Governing Body hereby approves the process initiated by the college for the recruitment of the assistant professors on a CHB basis.
