Item No. 8

Recommendation of academic council pertaining to academic affairs with reference to New Education Policy 2020

Hon. Principal Dr. N. P. Tendolkar informed about the characteristics of New Education Policy, 2020. He further on discoursed that the govt. focuses on the new skill based courses as a support to the traditional courses for the sake of enhancing the employability of students. The motive behind attaining the autonomy is to introduce the skill-based courses in support of the conventional education and the college is moving in this direction with a proper framework. The college had submitted proposals to UGC seeking approval to four B. Voc. Programs in four different trades. Hon'ble UGC has accepted and approved all four trades under NSQF (Vide letter nsqfugc2020@gmail.com dated on September 23, 2020).

Hon'ble Principal Dr. N. P. Tendolkar added that considering the need of the time the college is thinking to add three years' integrated new program in Accounting and Finance for the

students belong to the Commerce. The management has also decided upon to establish a Satellite Center at Kadwai to avail students educational facilities for degree education. The Kadwai area falls in Sangmeshwar Tehsil. It is 35 km. away from Devrukh and it is a hilly area. It is exasperated and easily inaccessible for the students of that area to reach at Devrukh for attaining Degree Education. For the said purpose, the DSPM contacted the Kadwai Education Society to establish a joint venture to avail the degree education facilities in their campus. The Kadwai Education Society happily agreed to extend full support for the smooth functioning of this program in their campus absolutely with social angle.

Hon. Principal Dr. N. P. Tendolkar continued with that the NCC was as an elective for Sports and Yoga in the Ability Enhancement Course in the year 2019-20. Considering the interest of the students, the college has decided to run the NCC as a separate paper for 02 credits. The syllabus and evaluation pattern is decided by the special core committee under the BoS in Geography.

Hon. President Mr. Sadanandji Bhagwat briefed about the ambitious plan that the institution aims for in the forthcoming years regarding the Science Center and Skill-based Education.

Hon. Dr. Mordhwaj Parihar appealed to the institute to undertake Communication Skill Enhancement Programs in collaboration with various reputed institutes in India and abroad as well. He explained his experiences of such courses conducted with the Cambridge University by some colleges in Madhya Pradesh and assured fullest cooperation for such collaboration with the Cambridge University.

Hon. Principal Dr. N. P. Tendolkar appreciated his suggestion and requested him to contribute in designing and developing such courses and collaborations in turn.

Hon. Dr. Mordhwaj Parihar appealed the institute to prepare timeframe for the conduction of vocational courses and insisted on suitable pedagogy; to be developed for these courses. He also added that western technology with Indian values can be the premier base of this new educational endeavor and college should think about a march in this direction.
