Mr. C.N. Hiremath put the whole F.Y. BCom Maths and Stat syllabus in front of the BoS members. Mr. Kshirsagar Dhananjay pointed out that the subunit having the concepts like Ratio, Proportion, Percentage with examples must be included in the FYBCom Maths and Stat syllabus.
