Lingayat, the exception followed with the Unit III of the Paper No VI E-Commerce from Second Semester in which the contents like E-customer relationship management, toolkit, life cycle, data mining in CRM, e supply chain management, supply chain, e-supply chain components, architecture, Customer effective web design, intelligent web sites, setting web sites goals, strategies for web site development, legal and ethical issues, IT Law 2000, phishing, copy right would be picked out from the existed syllabi.
