1. To Confirm the Minutes of the Third BoS Meeting Held on March 9th, 2022

According to the discussion that Mr. Ajinkya Naphade initiated, the focus of the meeting is on how to implement NEP 2020 in the next academic year. Dr. Jyotsana Dongardive suggested that make a template or framework of the multiple entry and exit so that it is easy to choose from it.

According to the discussion, Dr. R.V. Kulkarni added that your college should follow the circulars and instructions from the University of Mumbai.

3. To Review the Multidisciplinary Four-year Degree as Suggested by the NEP 2020

Mr. Ajinkya S Naphade, the chairman of the BoS reviewed suggestions from NEP 2020 regarding a four-year Multidisciplinary degree.

Dr. S. D. Bhoite suggested that a four-year multidisciplinary degree, structure, and patterns should be unified so that other institutes and universities will not face any issues in the admission process.

Dr. R. V. Kulkarni suggested that the focus should be more on research-specific curricula for the fourth year of graduation. He also added, it is too early to make necessary changes in the current pattern.

Dr. Jyotsana Dongardive expressed her gratitude towards the

Multidisciplinary four-year degree.

According to the discussion, the following resolution was passed.

It is resolved unanimously that the Multidisciplinary four-year degree should be implemented from the next academic year, but wait for the final instructions from respective authorized government bodies.

4. To Review Credit Structure as Suggested by the NEP 2020

Ms. Piya More, the BoS member, reviewed suggestions from NEP 2020 regarding credit structures.

Dr. Urmila Pol suggested that NEP is implemented by the Department of Computer Application (BCA), Shivaji University w.e.f Academic Year 2022-23. The BCA department modified the syllabus for the first year as per suggestions from NEP 2020. The BCA department also follows the guidelines regarding the credit structure as per NEP 2020.

Dr. Jyotsana Dongardive expressed her gratitude towards the credit structure and suggested that Somayya University, D. Y. Patil University, Indore University, and many more universities are currently implementing NEP in their universities. So we can take input from them.

Ms. Anuja Gharpure expressed her gratitude toward the credit structure. According to the discussion, the following resolution was passed.

It is resolved unanimously that the credit structure should be followed as suggested in NEP, also take inputs from various universities and institutes who implemented NEP but wait for the final instructions from respective authorized government bodies.

Dr. Jyotsana Dongardive suggested that the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) is the first baby step taken by the government to share and transfer credits.

Ms. Piya More added that our college is also enrolled in ABC and student enrollment is in process.

Mr. Uday Bhatye expressed his gratitude towards the credit transfer and suggested that wait for the final guidelines from the university. According to the discussion, the following resolution was passed.

It is resolved unanimously that the assessment process should be followed as suggested in NEP, but wait for the final instructions from respective authorized government bodies.

6. To Review Dual, Joint, and Twinning Degrees as Suggested by the NEP 2020

Ms. Piya More, the BoS member, reviewed suggestions from NEP 2020 regarding dual, joint, and twinning degrees.

Dr. Urmila Pol and Ms. Gausiya Khanche also expressed their gratitude for dual and joint degrees.

Dr. S. D. Bhoite added that don't make changes too early, let's wait and watch for the final instructions. According to the discussion, the following resolution was passed.

It is resolved unanimously that the dual, joint, and twinning degree should be followed as suggested in NEP, but wait for the final instructions from respective authorized government bodies.
