Resolutions:

- i) It was resolved to accept and approve the minutes of the meeting held on Jan 20, 2023.
- ii) After the review of syllabi of UG semester-I & semester-II Major Physics courses, it was resolved that the same be finalized
- iii) It was resolved that the same physics theory courses will be provided to the students opting physics as major or minor subject. But, there will be an additional set of two minor physics theory courses for students opting Computer Science major. While major courses will have separate major practical course, practical courses for minor subjects will be provided as Vocational Skill Courses (VSC). It was accepted unanimously.
- iv) After the review of syllabi of UG semester-I & semester-II Minor Physics courses (those mostly expected to be taken by students opting computer science major), it was resolved that the same be finalized
- v) After the review of syllabi of PG semester-I & semester-II Physics courses, it was resolved that the same be finalized.
- vi) It was resolved that Research Methodology course from University's PG Curriculum (course code 506) will be taken as Research Methodology course (course code - S509PHT) in Semester – I.
- vii) It was resolved the evaluation pattern will be 60% external examination and 40% internal whereas the detailed evaluation pattern will be as decided by the examination committee.
