The meeting commenced with the warm welcome of all the members of BOS by the BOS Chairman Dr. Naikwade.

Dr. Pratap Naikwade informed the members that due to COVID 19 pandemic it is not possible to conduct offline meeting so online mode is preferred for Botany BoS meeting. In earlier years BoS framed Syllabus of FY BSc Botany in 2019-20 and SY BSc Botany in 2020-21. As ASP College Devrukh does not provide Botany subject at third year level this year we are not going to frame any new syllabus. So regular agenda of BoS will be discussed in today's meeting. Dr. Naikwade also informed members that from this year new academic programme B.Voc. in Sustianable Agriculture has been started by Botany Dept. Official MOU was also signed with Nature Care Fertilizers for the course. All members congratulated Botany Deptand the college for the new B.Voc. Course.

2. Finalization of previous BOS meeting

Dr. Bansode read the meeting of previous meeting of Botany BoS meeting held on July 7, 2020. Dr. Sanap opined that meeting minutes well written and should be finalized.

3. Review of the syllabus prepared of F.Y. and S.Y. B.Sc. Botany

Dr. Naikwade told that syllabus of F.Y. and S.Y. B.Sc. Botany prepared by BoS is very well by students and parents also gave good feedback about the syllabus and don't require any changes or modifications. Ms. Sharayu Dalawi told that syllabus is well organized; Dr. Kedage told that it is perfect considering local relevance and current trends in Botany subject.

Resolution: It is unanimously resolved that no changes are required in F.Y. and S.Y. B.Sc. Botany syllabus so it can be taught to students without any modification.

4. Review of online modes used for syllabus completion in academic year 2020-21

Dr. Naikwade briefed about online modes used for syllabus completion in academic year 2020-21. He told that majority of syllabus was completed by using video lectures and online lectures on Zoom and Google meet platform. He also added that he has started Youtube channel where video lectures are uploaded based on syllabus of FY and SY students. Dr. Bansode added that separate Google classrooms were prepared for Fy and SY Botany class and syllabus, links of video lectures, assignments, question bank, notes, PPTs, study material is uploaded on google classroom. Majority of students

benefitted this online mode of teaching. Dr. Shimpale and Dr. Ade also shared their experiences of online teaching at their institute. Dr. Ade suggested that Microsoft team is also useful software for online teaching which has been used at Savitribai Phule University, Pune.

Dr. Bansode told that various national and International webinars were organized by Botany Dept. throughout the year as follows.

Dr. Shimpale suggested that Course on gardening and landscape designing will be beneficial for the students
