The meeting of BoS in Botany started with the warm welcome of all the members of BOS by the BOS Chairman Dr. Naikwade.

In the beginning of the meeting, Dr. Pratap Naikwade told that as per convenience of members, online mode is preferred for the meeting. He briefed about various activities, workshops, webinars organized by Dept. of Botany in academic year 2022-23. He gave information about International workshop on International Workshop on Emerging Trends in Education system in Sweden and India on 25 Feb. 2023 in which 22 teachers and students from Sweden participated along with ASP College teachers and students. All members congratulated Botany Dept for the success of International Workshop. Dr. Naikwade told that as NEP 2020 guidelines, new courses will be introduced in upcoming academic year 2023-24. Being an autonomous college, ASP college has prepared Credit pattern as per the NEP-2020, as per Govt. guidelines. BoS framed various courses syllabi as per NEP 2020 for FY BSc Botany and other students which will be finalized in today's meeting.

4. Framing new syllabus for F.Y. B.Sc. Botany and other course as per NEP 2020

Dr. Naikwade presented draft of new syllabus of F.Y. B.Sc. Botany considering suggestions by various stakeholders. He also presented draft of syllabus of Indian Knowledge System (IKS) course, Open/General elective course- Basics of Organic Farming, Value Education Courses – Environmental Science, Values in Life, Skill Enhancement Courses – Practical Skills in Botany, Principles of Fruit and Vegetable Processing in meeting. Dr. Alok Gude appreciated that curriculum of courses like IKS, SEC, VSEC are as per NEP 2020. Dr. Navnath Kashid opined that syllabi of all the courses are very well prepared, includes important concepts and will be useful to students.

Resolution: It is unanimously resolved that new syllabus of F.Y. B.Sc. Botany and other course IKS, SEC, VSEC as per NEP 2020 approved
