**1.** To review current scenario of the syllabus designed for TY under NEP Implementation.

Dr. Arvind M. Kulkarni briefed the meeting about the subjects and paper & evaluation pattern and Syllabus being implemented for third year B.Com. He said that already the draft has been sent along with the notice and agenda to the respected members for perusal. He invited suggestions if any or comments on the syllabus.

Dr. Rupali Ambadkar from Sayajirao Gaekwad University, Baroda opined that the syllabus prepared for the Third Year B.Com is as per the requirement of NEP and all aspects have been covered. She suggested that in Cost accounting, the standard and marginal costing topics be separated and given more weightage. She also opined that the cost and financial reconciliation topic need not to be given separate weightage and can be included as a part of theory in the Cost sheet topic.

Dr. Susmita Daxini expressed the satiscfaction for considering the suggestion to change the Commerce Third year subject and including Indian Ethos in Management and Geo Politics and Trade for the Semester V & VI. She also congratulated for the syllabus of Geo Politics and Indian Ethos Management for meticulous preparation.
